LECTORS & USHERS need to be here early that weekend! And on Easter!!

LECTORS will be using cycle “B” readings for Sundays of Lent.

Lectors are asked to also prepare themselves to help read parts of the Gospel as found in the Breaking Bread Hymnal, on Passion/Palm Sunday (page 50) on Good Friday (page 61).

Lectors need to be prepared to read the Passion along with the Presider and Assembly. It is very important that you look over the readings during the previous week and refer to the pronunciation guide for some of those interesting names! We will follow the parish missal for Good Friday & Palm Sunday for the gospel.

****Lector’s for 9 am Masses on March 4th, 11th, & 18th are asked to be ready to read the Gospel of Cycle “A” with the Priest. The first and second reading will still be from Cycle “B”.**

Gospels for [March 4th-John 4:15-48, 11th, John-9:1-41 & 18th-John 11:1-45, 9]

USHERS need to be prepared also!

At All Masses, the community will gather in church. **On Palm Sunday, Ushers please distribute palms as people arrive in church.**

The Masses on Easter morning are crowded and so your help is much needed in finding seats for parishioners and guests and helping out in whatever way you can!

ALL MINISTERS volunteer on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil (with exception of Lector’s) & Easter Sunday.

ALTER SERVERS please remember to volunteer at any masses you attend during the year.

Fr. Doug greatly appreciates your help, especially on Holy Thursday, Good Friday & Easter Vigil. Please volunteer on the sheets in the sacristy.
